Back in the Box

A number of years ago John Ortberg wrote a fantastic little book called *When the Game is Over it All Goes Back in the Box*. In short, John calls every believer to consider the 'game' of life and the resources each person uses to either succeed or flounder in their personal and spiritual journey.

What's interesting is how you define the game of life and the resources it takes to succeed and indeed, by the world's standards, win the game. For example, you might define being successful at life as having the most financial resources, the biggest house, best education or maybe even the greatest health.

But when you die everything you've amassed at the game of life goes straight back in the box. You won't take the material possessions or financial wealth with you. Essentially, the game of life finishes the same way it started and the only things you get to walk away from the table with are the very same things you had when it started – your own soul and the relationship you built with your creator.

It's interesting that one person could be simultaneously "winning" at the game of life but losing at the game of eternal life, fixing their eyes on material things that they won't take with them when they die.

Jesus was preaching one time and compared earthly and eternal treasures. In a passage that we've come across at least a few times in our teaching series called **Money Matters**, he says:

“Don't store up treasures here on earth, where moths eat them and rust destroys them, and where thieves break in and steal. Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be.” (Matthew 6:19-21, NLT)

What is your deepest desire? To be seen as successful, relevant, important, indeed, to be known? Isn't that why people play the game of life in the first place, to be approved of and be known by others?
